In compliance with state law, Glenbeigh is providing this price list containing our charges for room and board, charges for outpatient services and laboratory services. The hospital's charges are the same for all patients, but a patient's responsibility may vary, depending on payment plans negotiated with individual health insurers. Uninsured or underinsured patients should consult with our admitting and billing staff to determine whether they qualify for discounts. Most uninsured and underinsured patients do qualify for significant discounts from these charges. These prices were originally effective January 1, 2008.

Fees for physician services are not reflected in the rates below and will be separately billed by your physician.

Room and Board -- Per Day Charges

The following charges reflect the most common room and board charges provided to Glenbeigh inpatients. Patients are likely to have ancillary charges in addition to these room and board charges. These ancillary charges could include pharmacy, laboratory and supply charges, depending on the specific services provided.
